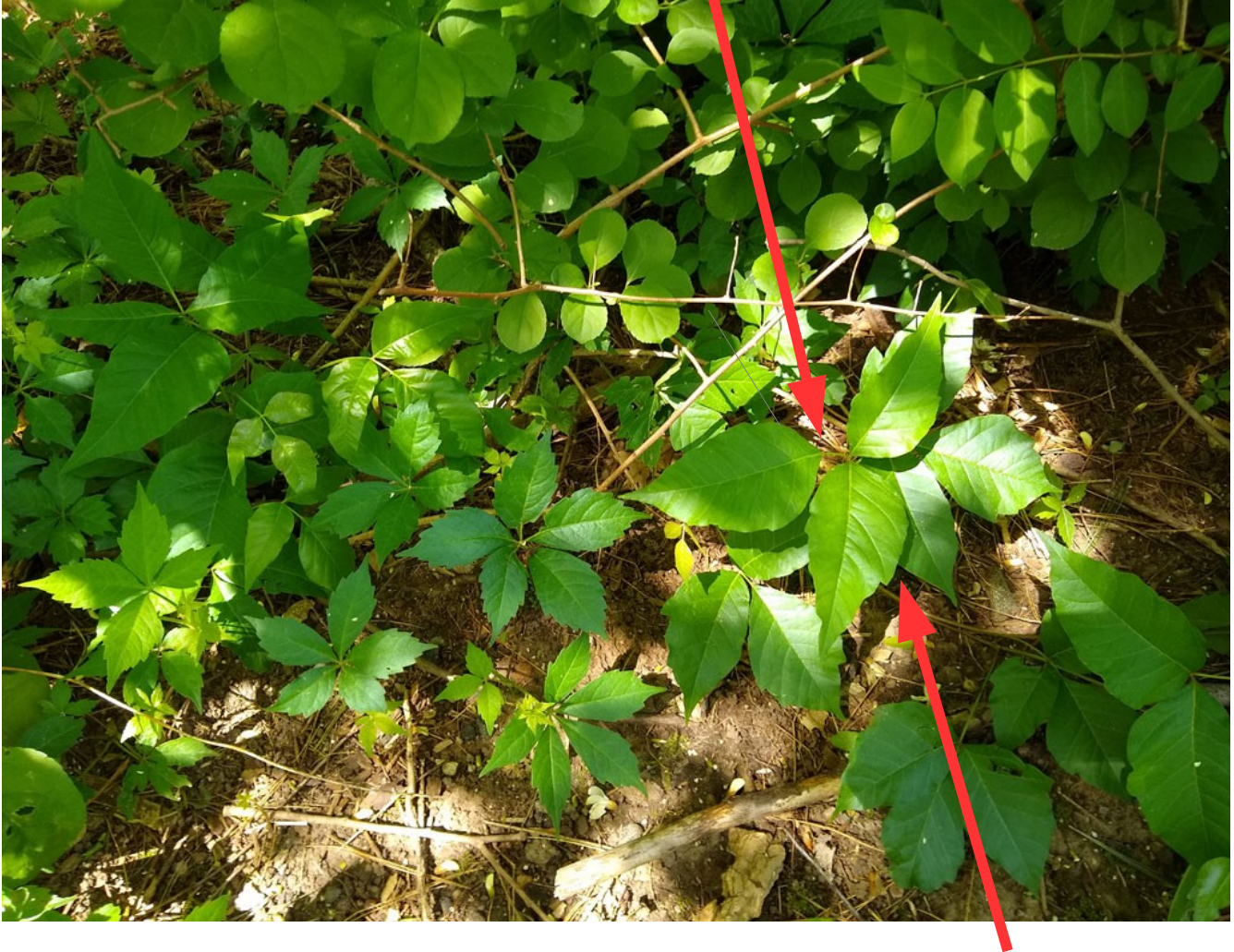


How to identify POISON IVY at Treetop Park !!

3 Leaves - “Leaves of three, leave it be!”

The **middle leaf is symmetrical** and has a longer stem.



The **side leaves are somewhat asymmetrical and often have notched or jagged edges**

The **leaves are usually shiny green but colors vary** from yellowish to orange and sometimes do not look shiny

It likes to hide among other plants (like the 5 leaf neighbor in this picture...)

It likes to climb trees and other plants (it is poison “ivy”...)

It loves the edges of forested areas like Treetop Park!!

The oil from the leaves and stems (whether dead or alive and leafy) causes nasty rashes on 85% of people. If you think you have touched it – immediately wash everything with a strong detergent if possible!
